Policy IX. 3	Volunteer Job Descriptions	Created: 11/19/15

**Policy:** To determine various opportunities for each volunteer based on level of service, skill set and individual interests.

**Purpose:** Volunteers will have a thorough understanding of the levels of service and types of volunteer opportunities available to them at VSC.

## Procedure:

- 1. Volunteer Coordinator will work with fellow staff to determine agency needs and create job descriptions based on those needs.
- 2. Volunteer job descriptions will be broken down into advanced service, indirect services, community work groups, and one-time volunteer opportunities.
- 3. Opportunities and job descriptions will be added, as needed, to the volunteer manual.
- 4. Volunteer opportunities and jobs will be separated into 2 service levels, indirect and advanced service.
- 5. Levels in service and job descriptions will be thoroughly review and provided to volunteers at Volunteer Orientation.
- 6. Job Descriptions will include:
  - a. Essential Duties and Job Functions
  - b. Requirements
  - c. Training & Paperwork
  - d. Time Commitment
